

## **Division of Humanities Higher Degree Research (HDR) Awards**

The Division of Humanities wants to acknowledge and encourage the excellent work being achieved within the area of Higher Degree Research.

Up to five prizes are available. Successful applicants will receive a certificate and an award of \$1000 available to be used for activities that promote Higher Degree Research, including the purchase of research-related equipment, running local colloquia, and conference travel, or in another manner as agreed with the Dean. Please note that winners in the 2007 round cannot be nominated for the same award in this round, though may apply for awards from other categories. The prizes will be awarded at the Divisional meeting on 24 October 2008.

We call for nominations for prizes in the following categories.

### **Staff Awards**

1. Best completion record for 2008
2. Best record for encouraging student publications 2007-2008 (measured through number/quality of student publications)

### **Student Awards**

1. Award for contributions to improving divisional research climate
2. Award for best publication 2007-2008
3. Award for contribution to raising profile of Humanities at Macquarie University internationally

### **Form of Application**

Nominations may come from staff or HDR candidates, and should include name and contact details of nominator and seconder, and contact information for the person nominated. The nominator should provide 150-word summary in support of their nominee. No self-nominations, please.

### **Selection Committee**

The submissions will be assessed by Associate Professor Michael Roberts (Acting Dean) and Associate Professor Marea Mitchell (Associate Dean, HDR).

### **Applications**

Applications are to be made directly to Carlene Kirvan, W6A 222, by no later than 5pm, 10 October 2008. No late applications will be accepted. Only one copy of the application is needed.
